Update on the Developments of Worcester, Massachusetts

Timothy P. Michael E. Traynor, Esq., Chief Development Officer, Executive Office of Economic Development, will accompany Tim Murray as they discuss the ever-changing landscape of Worcester's downtown. Mike will highlight the role that the Worcester Redevelopment Authority has played in the City's urban renewal planning process and touch upon the various land acquisitions and business relocations that are required to make the revitalization a reality.

Speaker Biographies:

A life-long Worcester resident, Tim was a former three-term Mayor of Worcester, New England's second largest city. Under his leadership, Worcester experienced unprecedented progress, with \$1 billion of new economic development projects, such as Gateway Park and City Square, that are helping to transform an older industrial city into one that is well positioned to lead and grow in the new economy.



Mike began his career with the City of Worcester as an assistant city solicitor elevating to deputy city solicitor in 1993 and taking on the role of Chief Development Officer in 2014. During his tenure as the CDO, he has negotiated the sale and redevelopment of the former Worcester County Courthouse, the Boys Club at Lincoln Square, facilitated the development of the South Worcester Industrial Park, the adoption of the Downtown Worcester Urban Revitalization Plan, and most recently was a key member of the City team that successfully negotiated the relocation of the Pawtucket Red Sox to Worcester.
